**The Parish Council Meeting started at 7.30pm with CW taking the chair
Public Session**

There was discussion about the proposed youth shelter and Central Shropshire Partnership funding. CSO Lyn Birch said there is a youth shelter in Monkmoor. It has been vandalised and would cost about £1500 to repair so CSO Lyn Birch will look into the possibility of acquiring it. It was agreed it may be more cost effective to go for a new one and an application will be put in for funding.

CW discussed the recent accident on the A458. The police cannot stop people from parking on the main road. Double yellow lines will be put in at some point and then it will be ParkRight's responsibility. The police won't issue tickets. CSO Birch said the police will monitor the road and ask residents to park on their drive or in the nearby car park.
